<p><b>ITEM 5</b></p> <p align="center"><b>PREPAYMENT OF CHARGES</b></p> <p>The LRPA reserves the right to require prepayment of charges published herein.</p>	<p><b>ITEM 40</b></p> <p align="center"><b>METHOD OF CANCELLING ITEMS</b></p> <p>As this tariff is supplemented, numbered items with letter suffixes cancel correspondingly numbered items in the original tariff or in a prior supplement. Letter suffixes will be used in alphabetical sequence starting with A. Example: Item 445-A cancels Item 445, and Item 365-B cancels Item 365-A in a prior supplement which, in turn, cancelled Item 365.</p>
<p><b>ITEM 10</b></p> <p align="center"><b>REFERENCE TO TARIFFS, ITEMS, NOTES, RULES, ETC.</b></p> <p>Where reference is made in this tariff to tariffs, notes, rules, etc., such references are continuous and include supplements to and successive issues of such tariffs and reissues of such items, notes, rules, etc.</p>	<p><b>ITEM 100</b></p> <p align="center"><b>SET-BACK CARS AND CARS DELIVERED IN ERROR</b></p> <p>A charge of \$330.00 per car (loads and/or empties) will be assessed against the carrier which delivers cars to the LRPA in error for return of the car; and/or cars to be set-back.</p>
<p><b>ITEM 20</b></p> <p align="center"><b>CONSECUTIVE NUMBERS</b></p> <p>Where consecutive numbers are represented in this tariff by the first and last numbers connected by the word "to" or a hyphen they will be understood to include both of the numbers shown.</p> <p>If the first number only bears a reference mark, such reference mark also applies to the last number shown and to all numbers between the first and last numbers.</p>	<p><b>ITEM 110</b></p> <p align="center"><b>CARS ORDERED BUT NOT USED</b></p> <p>When order for cars for loading is canceled or car is returned empty, a charge of \$225.00 per car will be assessed against person, firm or industry ordering such car (See Notes 1 and 2).</p> <p>Note 1 - Charge will not apply on cars not being in proper condition to load, see Item 120.</p> <p>Note 2 - Applicable Demurrage Charges will apply.</p>
<p><b>ITEM 30</b></p> <p align="center"><b>DEMURRAGE AND STORAGE RULES AND CHARGES</b></p> <p>Subject to Demurrage and Storage Rules and Charges as provided in Tariff RIC 6004-series, except as shown below:</p> <p>EXCEPTION: Demurrage for Unit trains, defined as the same type cars brought in for one customer in quantities of 30 or more cars to be loaded/unloaded with a single commodity and bound for a single destination, will be billed to LRPA Customers in the amount equal to the net car hire billed to the LRPA. [A]</p>	<p><b>ITEM 120</b></p> <p align="center"><b>CARS NOT SUITABLE FOR LOADING</b></p> <p>When cars ordered for loading are refused or rejected on account not being in proper condition to load, a charge of \$225.00 per car will be assessed against the carrier furnishing such car.</p>
	<p><b>ITEM 130</b></p> <p align="center"><b>SHIPMENTS OF EXCESSIVE DIMENSIONS, WEIGHTS, ETC.</b></p> <p>The LRPA will not accept from shipper or connecting carrier for transportation shipments of excessive dimensions, excessive weight, high center of gravity or other conditions requiring special handling without the LRPA first being contacted in advance to obtain authorization for such shipments.</p>
