**GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS**

ITEM	SUBJECT	APPLICATION
1 [A]	FUEL RECOVERY SURCHARGE	In the event the average price of West Texas Intermediate Crude Oil exceeds \$23.00 per barrel, the MGRI reserves the right to apply a fuel surcharge to charges in this tariff for the movement of cars in switching or any other service, up to an amount not to exceed that provided for by Item 12000-series of Tariff CSXT 8100-series.
